## 2.8.0 Application Note

If you get a message informing you of a conflict in the com ports, it should be followed by a prompt for a new com port for the ICOM radio. If you do not have an ICOM attached just make up a com port number that is different from your FSX com port. I believe Jim Brown is the only one with a ICOM receiver attached to his RSS. This feature is there for Click and Tune To usage so that you can listen to the signal at some given frequency on the spectrogram. Jim was using this to capture audio from N bursts. We used to use it at WCCRO as a general feature so you could listen to signals remotely. It will work with the R-75 or R8500.
