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I have released into the wild version 2.9.25 of Radio-Sky Spectrograph.

You can use the Help / Check for Updates menu to get the new update. The new full install also is version 2.9.25, so new installs will not need an update.

A lot of changes went into this release so you may find a bug or two. Please let me know if you find anything. This version has the new PDF help file, and includes most of the suggestions people have made. I will further improve the pdf as I have time to do so. Thanks to those who took time to look at the nearly 50 pages and make suggestions.

Please take some time when you can to play with the new Annotations feature. Annotations will have the advantage of being search-able for researchers using the data in the future. Annotations are saved in a comma separated value (CSV) file in the same directory as the SPS file. You can go back through any of your years of data and add annotations. The list of predefined annotations (annotations.txt) is provided. We need to establish a standard list to make searching easier.

You do not need to make any immediate changes to your system with this update, however if you own one of the automatic calibrators, please arrange for a time with me when I can update the firmware in your calibrator via TeamViewer. Evenings EST are best.
